





OPEN DATA


- -Data that is generally provided at no cost
- -Previously needed to request via CPRA
- -No licensing requirements or constraints
- Machine readable via Application
 Programming Interfaces (APIs) and/or
 Web Services
- -Viewable by humans
- Some data must be redacted for privacy and security

OPEN, REUSABLE DATA BENEFITS

- Enables outside businesses to develop new insight, services, and products
 - Sharing can be a two-way street: outside developers and vendors can share data back after adding value
- Increases data visibility inside and outside the organization
 - Can build efficiencies to staff and constituents

EDUCATION-FOCUSED MAKERSPACES



What is an "Education-Focused" Makerspace?

- A facility full of traditional and state-of-the-art industrial art tools, equipment & instructors.
- A place where anyone can gain real-life, practical skills.
- Like a gym. Monthly membership, pick what you want to learn and come back when you like.
- Make "better" engineers & students! Not a replacement for school, college.
- Create a supply of (entry level, but skilled) people for industry and manufacturing.
- Helps bring ideas to market a business incubator, a dream garage, and an R&D lab for existing businesses.


