Program Objectives

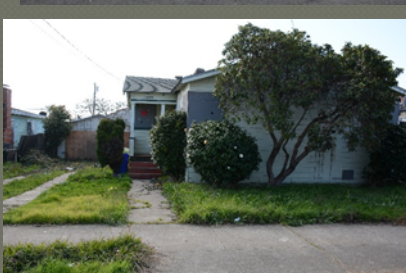
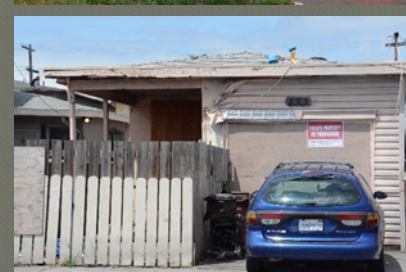
- Identify, acquire, rehabilitate and sell dilapidated, abandoned housing stock
 - Create clean, safe and decent housing – appropriate to neighborhood
 - Provide opportunities for First Time Home Buyers through SparkPoint
 - Stabilize neighborhoods
- Create Social Impact Bond Financing Model to recycle funding to maximize number of housing units in the program

Target Properties

- Unaddressed code violations
- Absent owners
- Vacant/abandoned
- Significant tax delinquencies
- Mortgage may or may not be foreclosed
- No one (nominal owners, banks, tax collector) will take responsibility for the property

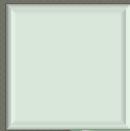


Possible Target Properties



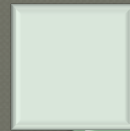
Program Operations

Phase 1 – Securing Properties



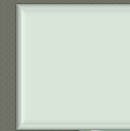
STEP 1

- Identify Properties
- Code Enforcement

- County Tax Collector



STEP 2

- Run Proforma
- Acquisition Price
- Rehab/ construction cost estimate
- Rehab timeline
- Market price estimate

- Acquire Property
- Tax sale
- Foreclosure
- Negotiated agreement
- Probate

 - Use of local contractors
 - Opportunities for local hiring



SparkPoint Buyers

SparkPoint Buyers will have completed the HUD first Time Home Buyer Program provided in partnership with Community Housing Development Corporation. Graduates will have:

- 680 Credit Score or better
- Up to 3 months of savings
- Debt to income ration of 40% +
- Income
- Down payment assistance

- ◉ Increased property tax revenue for the City of Richmond
